ORDINANCE LEVYING OCCUPATIONAL TAXES FOR THE CITY OF LIVERMORE, KENTUCKY

ORDINANCE NO. 4-87-A1

BE IT ORDAINED BY The CITY COUNCIL of the CITY OF LIVERMORE, MCLEAN COUNTY, KENTUCKY, AS FOLLOWS, TO WITH:

<u>SECTION ONE:</u> That Ordinance No. 4-87-A1, an ordinance levying occupational taxes for the City of Livermore, Kentucky is hereby amended to read as follows:

That there be, and there is hereby levied an occupational tax or license tax for revenues for the general expenses of said city <u>for the year 2016</u> (for the year 1987) effective and for each year thereafter, upon the following occupations.

On all persons or firms engaged in merchandising in the city, except persons or firms having a principal business situs outside of the State of Kentucky, or offering for sale any of the hereinafter named lines or departments of merchandise, whether said lines be carried separately or in connection with other lines mentioned, regardless of the name in which they are sold or offered for sale, the following occupational tax or licenses shall be paid, viz.

It is further ORDAINED that all persons who expect to engage in business or occupations named in the above schedule must make application on printed blanks supplied by the City.

Every licensed business shall keep posted in a prominent place upon the licensed premises, the license certificate. Other licensees shall carry their license certificates with them at all times while conducting business in the City and shall produce said license for review whenever requested by an officer of the City.

Any person who engages in any trade, occupation, or profession herein listed, (exoperates a motor vehicle on the Livermore public streets,) without first procuring the applicable license shall be deemed guilty of a <u>Class A</u> misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be fined a sum not less than (\$5.00) \$50.00 nor more than (\$50.00) \$500.00 to which may be added the tax herein imposed.

All license fees or taxes which are not paid within 30 days from the date they become due and payable (July 1 of each year except for one day licenses) shall be assessed a penalty of 10% of the fee or tax required for that particular business, occupation, or profession, which penalty, together with the regular fee or tax, shall be paid before the license is issued.

Each retail store owner or operator in the city shall furnish the city clerk a list of the names and addresses of the companies with which they do business who sell product or provide a service. The list shall be furnished each year before May 1st.

The said license is not transferable and is good only for the time specified there in and the unused portion of any license shall be surrendered to the City Clerk without refund.

(All vehicle licenses shall be displayed in a prominent place on said vehicle not later than fifteen (15) days after July 1, 1987, and on the same date annually thereafter. Said license shall be issue with a receipt showing the license number.)

Applicants for new trade or occupation licenses will be charged the full amount of the tax if they are purchased during the first quarter of the year after July 1 (, 1987) of any year;

three-fourths (3/4) if purchased in the second quarter; one-half (1/2) if purchased in the third quarter; and one-fourth (1/4) if purchased in the last quarter of the year after the said July 1 ($\frac{1}{1}$) due date. The same schedule shall apply for all subsequent years.

The City Marshall or duly appointed tax collector for said City shall have the same power to collect said taxes, together with penalties thereon, as sheriffs have to collect the county and state revenue, and my distrain for the collection of said taxes and penalties at any time after it is due, and in the manner of sheriffs in collection of state revenue.

It shall be the duty of the Marshall of the City of Livermore, Kentucky, to enforce the provisions of this LICENSE ORDINANCE and the failure or neglect on the part of the Marshall to enforce the provisions of this ordinance shall be grounds for dismissal.

City sponsored events are exempt from Occupational Taxes.

This ORDINANCE is to be in effect on and after its passage and publication according to law. All ordinances or portions thereof in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
