

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LIVERMORE
AMENDING THAT CITY ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING
HOURS OF OPERATION FOR PUBLIC PARKS IN
THE CITY OF LIVERMORE, KENTUCKY

ORDINANCE NO. 2-96

WHEREAS, on October 9, 1986, the City Council of Livermore, Kentucky, enacted Ordinance 8-86 establishing hours of operation for public parks in the City of Livermore, Kentucky; and,

WHEREAS the City Council has previously amended said ordinance; and,

WHEREAS the City Council has determined that it is desirable and appropriate to again amend said ordinance;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF LIVERMORE, KENTUCKY, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I.

Section I. of said Ordinance No. 8-86, as amended, is amended as follows:

- A. No person shall enter, remain or be present in, use or utilize for any purpose whatsoever Riverfront Park, or any part thereof, or the basketball court or parking lot, or any part thereof, on the south side of the Livermore City Building, located in the City of Livermore, Kentucky, any time between the hours from 9:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m., local time.
- B. No person shall enter, remain or be present in, use or utilize for any purpose whatsoever any public park, or any part thereof, located in the City of Livermore, Kentucky, other than Riverfront Park, or any part thereof, and other than the basketball court or parking lot, or any part thereof, on the south side of the Livermore City

Building, as referred to hereinabove in SECTION I. A., any time between the hours from 11:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m., local time.

SECTION II.

All other sections and clauses of the aforesaid Ordinance of October 9, 1986, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect except as amended herein.

SECTION III.

All ordinances, resolutions and orders, and parts thereof, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict, and this Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its enactment and publication as provided by law.

Motion to record was made by Sartain, seconded by Ford, at a regular meeting on July 11, 1996.

Motion for passage was made by Sartain, seconded by Shocklee, at a regular meeting on August 8, 1996 with 5 members present and 5 members voting for passage of this Ordinance.
